Steps to Success ("Steps") gives local students from low-income families a step up on the path to a successful career. Steps works to narrow the economic opportunity gap by providing long-term educational enrichment and support for over 300 students in the Public Schools of Brookline.

Your support transforms lives by giving Steps students access to the same kind of academic support and professional role models available to their more affluent classmates. Your show of civic pride and generosity also raises your local profile, generates goodwill, and fosters relationships among other top individual supporters and Brookline community leaders.

Who Are Steps Students?

The vast majority of Steps students live in Brookline Housing Authority (BHA) or subsidized housing, and most are students of color. The typical Steps family survives on less than \$20,000 per year, creating an acute experience of income inequality for Steps students among their Brookline peers. Over 75% of Steps' student households are led by single women.

Steps' Personalized Approach and Lifelong Impact

Steps staff works individually with each Steps student, supporting them at every step from Grade 4 through college graduation. This long-term, sustained investment yields amazing results: over 95% of Steps students finish college in 4-6 years seven times the national average for first-generation college students. Steps works!

Collaborative and Community Supported

Steps collaborates closely with the Public Schools of Brookline and BHA to leverage resources and provide coordinated services to Steps students and their families. Local businesses and organizations are also vital to our mission, providing volunteers, mentors, internship placements, and financial sponsorship.
